1. **Objection #1 (3:1-2)**
If Jews and Gentiles are judged alike,
then there is no advantage in being God's covenant people.

2. **Objection #2 (3:3-4)**
If the unfaithfulness of some Jews bring judgment,
then man's faithlessness can nullify God's faithfulness.

3. **Objection #3 (3:5-6)**
If man's sins can show God's goodness,
then why should he be punished for his sins?

4. **Objection #4 (3:7-8)**
If man's sins show God's glory,
then shouldn't we sin more in order to glorify God?

Thoughts to Remember

- God is faithful to his promises and justified when he judges.

- We should never take God's faithfulness for granted.

- A flippant attitude toward sin is a sure sign of an unregenerate life.
