

I. Sin entered humanity through one man. (15:12a,c)

1. Adam introduced sin to humanity.
2. Sin became interwoven into humanity's DNA.
3. Humanity suffers from the consequence of Adam's sin.

II. Death entered humanity through sin. (15:12b)

1. Death is spiritual separation from the Eternal.
2. Death is physical separation from the body.

III. Sin and Death claims all of humanity. (15:13-14)

Truths to Remember:

1. We are fellow sinners.
2. Death should remind us that we are separated from the Eternal.
3. If one can infect humanity with Sin and Death, there must be one who can bring forgiveness and Life.
